Fob Reader:

A collaboration between Break Free Technologies and Right Way Elevator. The theory was they could remove the call button and replace it with the fob reader. But as put into operation the button plays a part in reading what floor the cars are on. So, it can call the closest car to the lower lobby.

They had to go back to Motion control, the company that helps in elevator programming electronics.
